## INTENSIVE SUPPORT SERVICES

THESE ARE SHORT-TERM SERVICES FOR PEOPLE WHO NEED A HIGH LEVEL OF SUPPORT WITH TWENTY-FOUR HOUR COVER.

Support is offered in shared and self-contained accommodation in various locations in Oxford City;

Rowan House  
Morrell Crescent  
Kate Turnbull House  
Cave Street.

The support will aim at helping recovery and empowering people to feel able to move on to a more independent setting within two years.

## TRANSITIONAL SERVICES

THESE ARE SHORT-TERM SERVICES OFFERING MEDIUM LEVEL ACCOMMODATION BASED SUPPORT IN THE CITY AND THROUGHOUT OXFORDSHIRE.

Accommodation is provided in various settings i.e. large and small shared houses and self-contained flats. The support will promote recovery with the aim of helping people to move on within two years to independent housing.

Sixty places are currently available in various locations in Oxford City and sixty places will be available in the county. County places are currently located in Bicester, Cholsey and Witney, with other places planned for Abingdon, Banbury, and Didcot.

## LONGER TERM SERVICES

THESE SERVICES ARE OFFERED TO PEOPLE WHO HAVE LONGER TERM SUPPORT NEEDS. THERE ARE THIRTY PLACES AVAILABLE IN SHARED HOUSING:

Grove House  
Lochgiel House  
Scrutton Close (self-contained flats).

Medium level support will be offered but residents will also have the opportunity to pay for "hotel services" such as cooked meals in a communal dining room, flat cleaning and a laundry service.

People who need domiciliary care will be referred for assessment and care will be available from either outside or in house providers.
